

# Archive & Restore

## *Easily Archive and Restore Projects*

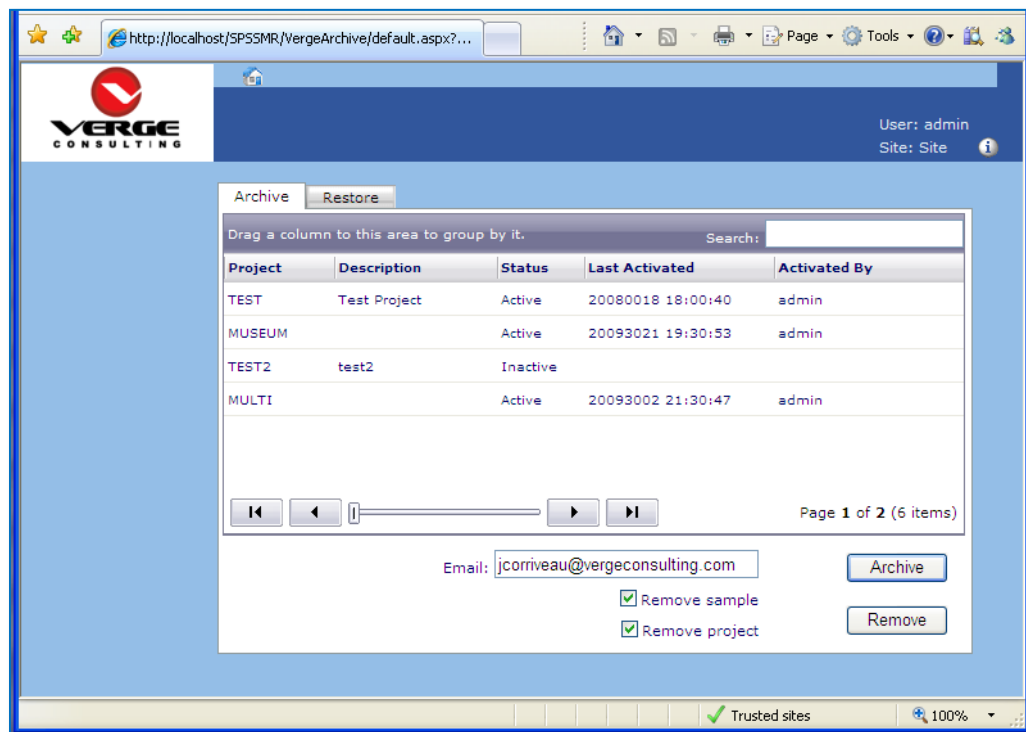
Does your company have an archive and restore process in place? Many companies have created manual or semi-automated processes for the backup and restoration of projects. And many times this relies heavily on IT resources. With the Verge Archive & Restore activity, it's as easy as 1-2-3.

1. Open the Archive & Restore activity from DimensionNet.
2. Select the project.
3. Click the "Archive" or "Restore" button.

Using an intuitive, web-based interface, you simply click on the projects you would like to archive or restore and click a button. In a few minutes, you will receive a confirmation email. No need to open a help ticket. No waiting. Do more and spend less with Verge.

Archive & Restore recognizes:

- Project files (Master, Shared, User directories)
- Project database (including Quotas)
- Sample table
- DPM properties (Project, Sample, Quota, Project Security)

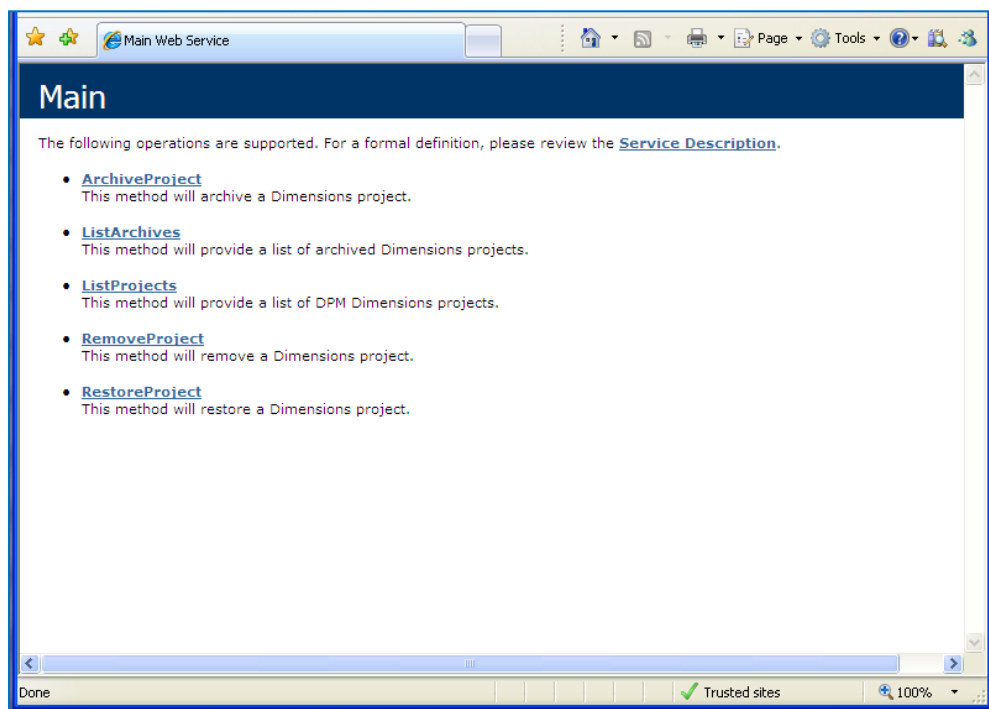

## Archive Restore Webservice

Archive & Restore also provides a backend webservice interface which can be used to automate the process of archiving projects. For example, you may want to archive projects on a nightly basis. Your IT staff can use this webservice to build an archiving process that fits your company's needs.

The Archive & Restore webservice can also be used for integration into your own home grown solutions (in place of using DimensionNet).
